Building on the success of the original TSEP model, these roles provide culturally safe support for Aboriginal social housing tenants and individuals experiencing or at risk of homelessness. Key duties include:

- Housing application assistance and tenancy sustainment
- Wraparound case management and referrals
- Community education, engagement and system advocacy
- Coordination with Link2Home, DCJ Housing and Specialist Homelessness Services (SHS)

These positions service the Murdi Paaki Region, which covers Bourke, Brewarrina, Broken Hill, Cobar, Collarenebri, Coonamble, Dareton/Wentworth, Enngonia, Goodooga, Gulargambone, Ivanhoe, Lightning Ridge, Menindee, Walgett, Weilmoringle and Wilcannia.

Successful applicants will be required to reside in one of the listed communities as part of their role.

This role is a great opportunity to help lead service transformation across the Murdi Paaki Region and support our mob to access safe and secure housing.
